### First Announcement of 2nd Ecobuildings Conference in Stuttgart, Germany, 7-8 April 2008

The second Ecobuildings Conference will be organised by the 4 projects BRITA in PuBs, Demohouse, Eco-Culture and SARA in Stuttgart, Germany on the 7th and 8th April 2008. The programme foresees presentations and posters on the in total 24 demonstration projects, on the other project results like tools, and a round table with high profile policy makers.
