New financing initiative to encourage energy efficient retrofit measures in public buildings in Germany

From January, 1, 2007, the German KfW Bankengruppe started a new initiative to encourage energy efficient retrofit measures in buildings owned by municipalities in Germany. The bank offers a special low loan (around 2% p.a.) for energy saving investments in the public building stock, like schools, kindergartens, gyms and administration buildings of registered associations.

European congress on energy-efficient building

As part of the Fair BAU 2007 Germany's Federal Ministry of Transport, Building and Urban Affairs (Bundesministerium für Verkehr, Bau und Stadtentwicklung) is putting on a European congress on the subject of energy-efficient building, on 15 and 16 January 2007. The congress will take a look at the regulatory environment and government support initiatives from a European perspective. Other emphases will be knowledge transfer and the latest technology.
